Parish Pastoral Council: Summary of May 3rd Meeting Minutes

STAFF CHANGES: Fr. Fleming reported resignations of Andrea Laux and David Thorp. A group of parishioners and staff is being formed to recruit and interview for both jobs and we hope to hire people early this summer. It was noted that Sandra Mueller has been extremely helpful to our parish since her retirement. **LONG RANGE SPACE**

PLANNING COMMITTEE: Data on parish space needs and description of our facilities has gone to Architectural Design Concepts, a space planning consultant. A group of parishioners will work with them over the summer to develop recommendations regarding our space utilization.

GREETING MINISTRY: Fr. Fleming commented on discussion from last meeting. He feels that Mass greeters will require substantial training. **STAFF ATTENDANCE**

AT PPC: The Director of Faith Formation and the Pastoral Associate will continue to attend PPC meetings and are expected to act as liaisons between the Council and parish staff. There will be no "calendar planning meeting" this year; dates are being gathered by email. It was agreed that an annual (at least) meeting of staff and PPC should occur to facilitate collaboration among parish ministries. **PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL CONSTITUTION:** Changes were discussed and recommendations made. Vote to occur at June meeting. **PPC ELECTIONS:** Five nominees have agreed to run for the three open positions including Tom Valle who is an incumbent. Fr. Fleming officially appointed Tom Valle (as one of his three potential appointments) to the PPC for the next two years so that the election will include four new nominees for the three open positions. Elections will occur over two weekends in May. **PASTOR'S REPORT:** Holy Week and Confirmation went well. Confirmation was especially "splendid" partly due to Fr. John Malloy, Interim Regional Vicar, who did an outstanding job presiding. Music was excellent and involved a number of youth. First Communion have been a beautiful experience. Fr. Fleming (and others) feel the Spirit alive in our church at these events.
