The Dream Team Day of Service is for Levels 1 & 2, as well as Peer Ministry!

We meet at the Parish Offices in West Concord at 9:00am. We aim to conclude the day by 3:00pm.

The Dream Team service day in 2011 will be Saturday, November 5.

What the Service Work is About:

The purpose of our high school religious education service activities is to experience what it means to live as a Catholic Christian today. Through the people you encounter and the work you do, you live the Gospel and experience Christian community.

We have partnered with the Concord Council on Aging for several years now to assist local residents with fall chores and tasks, mostly leaf raking, checking smoke detectors, and other seasonal chores. Students and parents are divided up into teams to go out into the community.

Logistics for the Day:

Participants should bring their own rake and gloves. If you have an extra rake, that may be helpful. Also, please bring tarps to help move leaves.

For this service work, you should dress comfortably, in layers, and dress for the weather - keep rain gear handy if there is a chance of rain, have a hat if it will be sunny, etc. It is good to have work shoes or boots, and heavy socks.

Participants should bring their own snacks, lunch, and something to drink.

This service day requires a lot of involvement from parents to drive, assist with the work, and help organize the day. In order to participate, parents need to have completed the Virtus training and the parish must have a current CORI on file.
